

Directions to Park End Street or Hotel Accommodation from Heathrow and Gatwick Airports

The nearest airport is London Heathrow. From there you can catch a coach or taxi directly to Oxford. An express train runs from Heathrow to London Paddington, which connects with train and coach services to Oxford.

Gatwick is London's second airport, from where you can also catch a direct train or coach to Oxford.

- A 24-hour express airport coach service links Heathrow Airport with Oxford. Please check the Timetables & Fares section of the website for specific timings.
- From Terminals 1 and 3 the coach leaves from Stop 14A at Heathrow Central Bus Station, and from Terminal 5 the coach leaves from Stop 10 at the arrivals concourse. From Terminal 4 free transfers leave from Stop 7 to the Central Bus Station and to Terminal 5.
- The approximate journey time to Oxford is 90 minutes from the Central Bus Station and 80 minutes from Terminal 5.

By Train

From Heathrow to London Paddington (The Heathrow Express)

- Direct trains run from Heathrow Airport to London Paddington Train Station every 15 minutes between 0503 and 2358.
- The approximate journey time is 15 minutes from Terminals 1 and 3 to Paddington, and 23 minutes from Terminals 4 and 5 to Paddington.

From London Paddington to Oxford

- Upon arrival at London Paddington you will need to take a train to Oxford. Our Park End Street campus is located directly in front of Oxford Train Station.
- Timetables vary but trains run about every 20 minutes between 0520 and 0020, and the journey takes about 60 minutes.

- From the airport, the coach leaves from the lower forecourt at the South Terminal (Stops 1 and 2), and from the lower forecourt at the North Terminal (Bays 4 and 5).
- The approximate journey time is 120–150 minutes.

By Train

From London Gatwick to Oxford

- There are a few direct train services between Gatwick Airport and Oxford, though many journeys require changing trains at Reading.
- Timetables vary but trains run at least every hour between 0330 and 2318, and the journey takes approximately 120–150 minutes.
