

EIASM Public Sector Emerging Scholars Programme - ESP Preliminary Programme 2024

The Emerging Scholars Programme (ESP) will take place at the Stockholm Business School on September 16th, 2024. <u>This event is only in presence for ESP accepted students</u>. ESP participation is free of charge for accepted students, but they need to be registered for the main conference (16 – 18 September), the 13th International EIASM Public Sector Conference - Public Service Accounting, Accountability And Management.

Emerging scholars are invited to submit a research proposal (including a literature review, research questions and research design). This research proposal may be either the proposal for the full PhD trajectory or one that focuses on a part of it. As such, also the opportunity is provided to discuss ideas about (succeeding) phases of the PhD. Accepted proposals will be presented to an audience of senior colleagues and peers. Participants are asked to be a discussant of another proposal. During the event, different sessions with Editors of high impact journals will be hold.
