Following the success of the last edition, the *Journal of Management and Governance* (JMG) is planning a special issue with the specific aim of exploring new developments within the context of Governance and Accounting Regulation. The Journal encourages the submission of both theoretical and empirical papers on this theme which should be also submitted and eventually presented in a special session of:

The Ninth International Workshop on Accounting & Regulation

which takes place in **SIENA** (Italy) on **June 19-21, 2023**, organised by the Department of Business and Law Studies (University of Siena) in collaboration with the European Institute of Advanced Studies in Management (EIASM).

The specific topic on Governance and Accounting regulation includes for example theoretical or empirical papers on the relation between corporate governance or ownership structure, and corporate financial and non-financial reporting, as well as the relation between the governance of institutions or regulators and reporting standards.

Authors should submit their papers to the special issue using the online submission system of the workshop [Announcement \(eiasm.org\)](http://eiasm.org). Deadlines are the same as for all papers submitted to the workshop: **March 26, 2023** (abstracts and/or full papers) and **May 22, 2023** (full papers).

Selected papers for the special session in the workshop will be evaluated following the usual review process the *Journal of Management and Governance* expected to be published conditional on satisfactory responses to reviewers’ comments.
